In order to your privacy, if you use the IRS DRT when completing the 2018–2019 FAFSA form on fafsa.gov , the government will not display your tax return information on the DRT web page, on your FAFSA form or on udent Aid Report (SAR). Instead, you'll see "Transferred from the IRS" in the appropriate fields faggov . If eligible, it is strongly recommended to utilize the IRS DRT. The IRS DRT remains the faggov . most accurate way to input your tax return information into the FAFSA form. The priority filing e for transfer students entering in Fall 2018 is March 1, 2018. The priority filing deadline for transfer sentering in Spring 2019 is November 1, 2018. Adelphi's federal school code is 002666.
